Our finalized departure date is **March 31, 2009**. We are doing everything possible to be ready to leave. What a blessing it is to see the end of the tunnel. May God be praised for His faithfulness during this pre-field ministry.

Please pray that all will go well with our move to Brazil. There is still some paperwork to be finished before we leave, and more to be done when we get there. Lord willing, Amanda will have her permanent visa before we get to Brazil. We are travelling to the consulate in Atlanta this week to get that done. Please pray that God will give us favor with those at the consulate.

Upon our arrival in Brazil, we will need to register with the American Embassy, get some Brazilian documents in order, get our belongings through customs, purchase a vehicle and find a place to live. In the mean-while, we will be living at my parents' house and using their vehicle.

Praise the Lord things are getting taken care of on this side of the move. We have been able to purchase a few items to take with us and have a few more to purchase before our departure. Timing is essential. Our van has already sold! Praise the Lord, because we hadn't even put it up for sale yet. We will be moving out of our house on March 19th and loading all our belongings into a container on the 20th.

As far as ministry is concerned the Lord has been opening many doors for us to minister to Brazilians all over the world. We are now receiving prayer requests through the website. This has opened the opportunity to work with several people, including people involved in the occult, Catholicism, and many who are bound by their sins and are begging for help. Sometimes we lose site of the real sin problem in our world and excuse it by trying to solve people's symptoms. May God find us faithful to give out the Gospel and bring these people to the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Please pray for us during this transition phase. Amanda and the boys will attend church without understanding a thing, they will be eating different foods, using different currency, and adapting to so many different things. To top it all off we are moving to the third largest city in the world and fighting traffic for hours. May the Lord help us to lean completely on Him during this time.

We want to thank each of you who have taken us on for support. We have enjoyed being with all of you. Without your financial help and prayers, we would not be leaving for Brazil at this time. May the Lord grant you rich rewards for your service to Him.
