Greetings to our friends and loved ones who are praying for us. We thank you for your constant prayers for us. It is evident by what God has done so far that there are people praying for us.

Many things have happened in the last month here in Brazil. First of all we must thank the Lord for saving souls. I had the opportunity to lead a 39-year-old man to the Lord this last Saturday. We had intended to visit his brother or his wife, both of which had visited the church recently. The Lord knowing what needed would take place sent his wife to a dentist appointment and his brother was not home either. Praise the Lord we were able to talk to Daniel without interruptions and point him to the Savior.

Several months ago a young lady named Janaina was saved and started attending the First Baptist Church of Parque Bristol. Her husband who had previously been saved and baptized, has now joined the church and is actively pursuing his family to come to Christ. Daniel is one of his uncles. Others in his family have also been saved. Several weeks ago two people in his wife's family were saved. Praise the Lord! It is exciting to see people get a burden to reach their family.

We have been helping in the First Baptist Church of Parque Bristol when not preaching or helping somewhere else. This has given us a bit more stability for our family and is especially helpful with the language. The boys are starting to understand the stories in Sunday School and even answering questions in class. They have made friends and enjoy playing and learning from them.

Once again we have begun to advertise our website online in an effort to spread the Gospel. During our last advertising campaign which lasted five months, we were able to see people from over 100 different countries around the world visit the website. In Brazil alone, people from over 100 different cities visited the website. We also received e-mails from about 50 people with questions about the Bible and salvation. Please pray that the Lord would use this tool to bring people to him.

The Lord has given us many opportunities to encourage churches in the area. Last month I mentioned preaching at a Father's Day retreat. The Lord blessed during that retreat. I believe the Lord did a lasting work in the hearts of many men that attended. Over 70 men were in attendance at the retreat.

Please pray for us this month as we seek to be a blessing here. I will start teaching some music lessons with a goal of developing a small orchestra for a church here in town. I will also be helping Pastor Marcos from Emmanuel Baptist Church with preparations for his missions conference in October and will be preaching on the first Sunday in October.
