

Dear Praying Partners,

October 2009

Greetings again from São Paulo, Brazil. This has been a very busy month. Just this last week I had the opportunity to preach six times. This month has also been a month of challenges, yet we were able to move forward and see people saved.

We started off the month with a preaching engagement in Carapicuíba. We were with a fellow missionary there. He invited us to come spend the day with them and speak at the church. Josiah played his trumpet for the first time in church on that Sunday. He really enjoyed it and is already planning what he wants to play around Christmas time.

On the 12th of the month there was a holiday. It amazes me how many holidays there are here. They all seem to be major holidays. This one was Children's Day. It is an excellent time to reach children from the neighborhood and that is what we did. About 50 children came to the activity, and 13 of them trusted the Lord as their Savior. Several of them have been back to church since and one boy's mother also trusted the Lord on a follow-up visit the next week.

Just a few weeks ago we got word that John and Julie received their visas and are making their final plans for arrival early in December. This is a long awaited answer to prayer. We are making preparations while we anxiously await their arrival. The Lord's timing is always perfect.

Amanda has just finished half of her language school studies and will press on until May when she finishes. She is a great student and is learning very quickly. She now is able to carry on quite a few conversations with the Brazilians and is enjoying being able to communicate a little better.

We have had some excellent break-throughs on our websites in the past month. Work is progressing, though slower than we would like. Please keep praying. At the 2010 World Cup in South Africa, a group of volunteers will be handing out 50,000 Portuguese tracts with our website address on them. May the Lord use this in a wonderful way.

Your prayers are much appreciated. We know that many of you are praying for us because we have seen the hand of the Lord working in many ways. Thank you so much!
