

Dear Praying Partners,

February 2010

This past month has been a very busy month in every way. Many things have happened on the world scene as well as in the local area here. After nearly 50 straight days of rain, the water has slowed just a bit. Life has been interesting to say the least.

In the last letter I wrote about a man named Rivaldo who had started coming to church and had many questions. Praise the Lord he is still coming and has only missed one Sunday morning. Please continue to pray for him and for his family who are deeply rooted in a charismatic church. He is trying to convince them they need to come to church with him.

About a week ago I had the privilege of leading Vitor to the Lord. He is a 13 year old boy. While Daniel (a layman in the church) and I were witnessing to Vitor, Daniel's wife was just around the corner leading another young boy to the Lord. The pastor has been training his people to win souls, but many are still hesitant and fearful. Praise the Lord she took the initiative and spoke to this boy who also trusted Christ as his Savior.

For the next two months I will have the opportunity to help train two men (Daniel and Dilson) to teach Sunday School. They will be teaching a class for new converts. This class will not only help the new believers, but it will also help train these men to teach God's Word.

A while back I mentioned the possibility of going into the prisons here in the São Paulo region. Well, after many months of waiting, and acquiring the proper documentation, the door is finally open. I will be going into several prisons on March 9th and 10th. This is an opportunity not only to minister, but also to learn how we can reproduce this ministry in Rondônia in the future. Our desire is to train nationals in Rondônia to start ministries like these.

We are praying that soon we will have the opportunity to visit Porto Velho as well as a few other places that the Lord has put on our hearts. Thank you for your prayers on our behalf. Please keep praying that the Lord will open many more doors.

### **Just a note about Porto Velho, RO**

A hydroelectric plant is being placed 10km from Porto Velho. The FUNAI, an organization that deals with Indians in Brazil, says there are 5 isolated Indian tribes within 14km of the center point of the plant. This means that these isolated tribes will be less than 16 miles from our future home.
