The length of these prayer letters only allows us to summarize what God is doing. Thank you so much for giving and praying. The Lord is giving fruit that will abound to your account.

December was full of blessings as we preached, went soul-winning, and worked on the literature ministry and other areas of preparation for our future ministry in Porto Velho. Our children also participated in a Christmas Cantata in one of the churches we have been helping.

A great door and effectual has opened for the Gospel here in Brazil. The Lord has allowed us to get involved in the ministry of a Brazilian national who is attempting to get into an area of this country where the Gospel has never been. Several Brazilian churches and individuals have joined in the effort to help him get there.

Last month we heard news that he was given a great opportunity to reach into a closed section of Brazil. Now we can say that the door is open even further. Where there was a possibility to reach one people group, there is now a possibility to reach dozens of people groups with the Gospel. The only thing hindering is the matter of transportation.

We have also been able to help a fellow missionary, Jim King, distribute some literature online. This is a great opportunity to provide good literature to hundreds and even thousands of people in the near future. Not only has he printed 13 very good books, but he also has a monthly paper.

We have been working on designing and printing our own tracts with our website on them. Praise the Lord, this is almost done. Within a week or so we should have those back from the printer. These tracts were designed so that we could reprint them as many times as necessary.

Thank you once again for your prayers and support. The Lord is doing some wonderful things. Just this last week after I preached in a conference a young lady named Carla raised her hand acknowledging her need for salvation. She then came forward during the invitation and trusted Christ as her personal Savior.
