While reflecting upon the events of the past few months, the Lord brought to my mind all the blessings that we have experienced as well as some difficulties. However, the blessings have far outweighed the difficulties. The Lord has been very good to us.

There is no possible way to fit into a prayer letter all that has happened since our last prayer letter. In the last 45 days, I have been away from home no less than 16 days. We have also had people in our home for at least an entire week other than that. Things have been very busy, yet we are glad for that.

Three weeks ago we spent the weekend with Pastor Marcelo and his wife Zinéia. Amanda was asked to speak to the ladies and I was asked to preach on Saturday night, Sunday morning and Sunday evening. We had a wonderful time getting to know Pastor Marcelo and his family. On Sunday evening, a lady trusted Christ during the service.

The past two weekends have also been very busy with traveling and preaching. I traveled to two new cities. One of these, Alvorada do Oeste, is in need of a good Bible preaching church. The other, Cujubim, has a small congregation of believers. Just this past weekend we had a three day teen activity there with lots of preaching. Please pray for this church as they seek lost souls for Christ in a very needy area.

John and Julie Kokenzie are heading our way shortly. They have rented a house and will be moving down from Itapuã this week. We are excited about their arrival. Please pray for them to be able to get settled without much difficulty. Their furniture and belongings have been stored for around six months. This will require quite a bit of work to sort through because of the amount of dust that settles in these parts. They also need to sell their vehicle in São Paulo and purchase another vehicle here in Rondônia.

The Lord has given us a few very good contacts here in Ouro Preto do Oeste. Yesterday my wife and I visited our land lady. The visit lasted several hours. We met her daughter and fiancé and had some coffee and cheese bread. Though I personally do not think she is at the point of salvation, she has taken us into her confidence and opened up about several issues in her life. While speaking on the phone yesterday she said, "Pastor, you are not my renter, you are my friend!" Please pray for Elcina.

There are countless souls that await the Gospel, thousands of Christians that await edification, hundreds of laborers that need to be trained and equipped, and work without end for anyone with a vision. We must press forward! Yet, we must press forward on our knees. There are not enough laborers for the amount of work.
