We want to thank every person who took the time to pray for us during this past month. We have been very busy getting our new rental property ready. It took us about a month to get all the paperwork together for the contract. The owner had never rented to a church before, so there were a few things to figure out in the process of signing the contract. Praise the Lord, all was taken care of and we now have a fixed location for the services of the church.

This past Sunday, October 19th, we held an inaugural service on Sunday evening. We have had Sunday morning services alternating between the Kokenzies' house and our house since we arrived here in town. These services have now moved to the new location and we also began a Sunday evening service to help us reach out to new people. Sunday evening is the time when most people go to church here in Brazil.

In our inaugural service we had 27 people. Though we had 40 chairs, we can comfortably sit around 30 in the auditorium. After that, it begins to be a little over-crowded, so we were happy with the turn out. We were pleasantly surprised to see a few neighbors in attendance. Several others we had visited during the week were also present. We are thankful for the wonderful day the Lord gave us.

God is working in Rondônia and we are glad to be a part of what is going on. Bro. Sam Rogers held his first mission conference at the end of September and we were able to help with a few things during their conference. Another Brazilian pastor is moving up to our state in the beginning of the year to establish a church. There are also three other missionaries that will possibly be moving to our state over the next while. Please continue to pray. There is still a great need, especially in the southern half of the state.

I have been trying to work out details for another trip to learn more about some of the not so distant Indian tribes. We will be traveling to a few cities in November to learn more and to make contact directly with the tribes. We are looking for an open door! Only God knows what we will find, but we ask that you pray earnestly for these isolated groups that to our knowledge have absolutely no Gospel witness in them.

Thank you once again for your prayers, support, and communication. So many have written to us during these past days letting us know that they would be praying for our inaugural service and the work at the new property. We know that the work here does not only depend on us. It depends on the prayers of God's people all over the world. More than ten churches contacted us letting us know that they would be praying specifically on the day of our inauguration. Many other individuals let us know also. May the Lord extend these prayers as the work continues. This is just another step in continuing the Great Commission in Brazil.
