We have already been here in Vilhena for over six months. God has done some wonderful things. We are excited about the future here! Let me tell you about the present though, so you will know how to pray for the future.

The Work in the Tribes

Since our arrival, we have been researching and asking many different people about the Indian tribes in the area. Recently we were introduced to a few people who have offered to take us to visit several of the tribes. Isaías and Bro. Ed Cook (our co-workers) recently visited one of the tribes in the area. We hope to visit another one this weekend. Please pray that God would open doors for ministry in one of these tribes. We hope to build relationships with the Indians and minister to them out of our church. Our goal is to provide a place for them to attend when they are in town also.

Another Church is Getting Started

Three hours from us, a lay family is working and praying that a church might be started in their small town. Our church has been interested in helping for a while. We have been looking forward to visiting them and helping them reach into the community. About six or seven weeks ago I met with the family and we planned a church trip up there for the 9th of April. The church people were excited about the trip and being able to help in the beginning of this church.

We left early in the morning on the 9th and returned after midnight. The trip was exhausting, but a blessing in most every way. The roads are very dangerous. The main interstate highway is full of large pot holes. Last year 111 people died on this highway in our state. Some of this is due to drinking, speeding, or careless driving, yet several accidents and deaths have been caused by the conditions of the roads. Please pray for safety as we travel back and forth to help these dear people. We hope to get up there once a month when schedules allow.

The Church Here in Vilhena

Our church here in Vilhena needs your prayers. We have been reaching out to many people around us. God has sent us a few visitors, but we are especially praying for the salvation of those attending and for spiritual growth in their lives. Each individual who attends our services has major problems in their lives. Some with marital and family problems, some financial trouble, some health issues, and others with legal problems. It has been very taxing on our small group, yet we believe that God has put every single one of these people in our path for us to minister to their needs. Though we minister to their spiritual needs, we cannot help but follow what the Bible says, "Let us do good unto all men..., Remember them that are in bonds..., He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD..., Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction..."

Can we be counted on to be "faithful over a few things"? (Mat 25:21) Will the Lord call us good and faithful servants? This is our prayer. May the Lord find us faithful!
