The past few weeks, Psalm 63 has been working on me. I have been preaching some messages on the life of David. Our people are not familiar with many of the Old Testament stories, so I decided to preach through some of the stories helping them glean lessons for life from them. This past Sunday evening after preaching on how David "enquired of the Lord," we had a great response to the message. About five people raised their hands saying they needed a personal relationship with Christ. Please pray that the Lord's perfect will is done in their lives and that they truly understand the salvation that He freely offers.

The church continues to grow. Numbers continue to rise. Dozens of people have promised to visit the services at the new location when we open the doors. It truly is amazing how many opportunities to witness we have had just because of the building. This past week I was working on the building when it started raining. Being a new subdivision, they are still finishing some of the development work. The men working like to take cover under our pavilion during their lunch hour or during the rain. For the few minutes that the rain hindered my work, I was able to witness to a few of the men that came to take cover.

The construction is slow, but steady. Every week we are out there laying a few more bricks or pouring more concrete. This past week afforded us a bit more opportunity with a holiday. We had five men out there from the church on that day. Otherwise, we have only been working on Fridays and Saturdays. If you have a free weekend and would like to come lay some bricks, pour some concrete, shovel some dirt, or help out somehow, just come on down!

We would appreciate your specific prayers over the next few months as we finish the construction of a house. We have been praying about this for years. At the end of August the Lord gave us peace about building. We have a narrow time frame with the rains quickly approaching and plans for a short furlough next year. This project has had us learning architectural design and structural engineering while also researching septic systems and every other facet of the process. There have been many challenging puzzles to solve, but in every one of them, the Lord has been our help. We have made many friends and acquaintances around town which we hope to soon see in church because of this. The house is about 50% done. Pray we will get enough done to live in it by December.

Lastly, we want to thank our supporting churches in Idaho. Through them, the Lord provided us with a motorcycle to get to the Indian tribe. After 15 hours of driving school, I now have my motorcycle license and am getting some practice in around town before trying to take a trip through the sandy jungle for the better part of a day. Anyone that has visited Brazil knows that most all who drive motorcycles here are crazy. So, what is your opinion? Is this a license allowing me to be crazy? If so, can I stretch it beyond the realms of driving?

Thank you again for your prayers and support. God's work is advancing! There is so much to be done. We believe the Lord still has much in store for us here in Vilhena. Please help us through prayer!
