Time is quickly passing. We are a third of the way through 2018. Let me catch you up on what is going on and what we have planned for the next few months.

The past few months have been very busy with construction work. We have been trying to finish the inside of our house before we leave for furlough. Praise the Lord, not only is the inside done, but several projects outside also. Thanks to three hard working boys, we were able to get quite a bit of work done. This is the first year they have ever regretted finishing school early!

Over the past month, we have concentrated most of our time at the church and preparing for the first service in our new building. On April 29th, we met for the first Sunday at the new location. I must say a special thank you to all who have been praying. We had 55 people in attendance (which is a record for us). We had more people than chairs! It was a wonderful day filled with excitement for our church family.

We have had several work days at the church and most everyone in the church was involved at one time or another. It was such a blessing to see the church working together. Pastor Isaias and I did quite a bit of the work leading up to the first service. We installed all the wiring, wood doors, toilets, sink, marble and much more including overseeing the work that was hired and the purchasing of all the materials. Josiah and Jonathan were also a very big help.

There are plenty of new pictures up on our website. Please take a look at them. It will help you understand a bit more about the construction and the process involved. Machines and power tools are not the most common items here. Much of the work is done with good old fashion shovels, hammers, hand made scaffolding, and other such things. It is amazing how much of the construction process is breaking what you have built. It does not always make sense, but it is one of the cultural differences that we must deal with.

In less than a week we leave for a three-month furlough. The Lord has answered two very specific prayers that we had concerning this furlough. We prayed for the Lord to give us someone to stay in our house. Three weeks ago the brother of one of our church members came to town. He is single and is staying with his brother's family. He agreed to stay here while we are gone. The Lord's timing is always perfect!

We will be visiting quite a few churches. Our schedule is almost completely full with little effort on our part. The Lord has allowed things to fall into place quickly allowing us to spend more time in the church part of things on this end.

Please keep praying about the situation with the Indians. We are at a standstill until they open up to us once again.

Thank you for your help. Many lives have been changed.
